Spain. 1992. The Barcelona Olympic Games and the Seville Universal Expo, together with the celebration of the 5th Centenary of the Discovery of America that same year, presented Spain to the international community as a modern, developed and dynamic country. Meanwhile in Cartagena, an industrial city in the southwest region of Murcia, protests against the closing of several factories and deindustrialization policies were becoming increasingly violent, finally resulting in a mass uprising that culminated with the burning of the regional parliament.



The Year of the Discovery will be screened in **Anthology Film Archives** on April 7, at 6.00 pm. followed by a Q&A with Luis López Carrasco.
